The San Diego Region SCCA will host the Western RallyCross National Challenge Championship event on September 26-27 at Soak City Water Park in Chula Vista, CA. This event follows the Eastern Challenge Championship the weekend prior and will be a show case of the who's who in RallyCross West of the Rockies. The SCCA Nationals will follow in Farmington Colorado two weeks later. This event is open to all competitors with a current SCCA Member card and individuals that complete a temporary SCCA Membership at the event site (\$15).
